

# SFUSD Family Engagement Plan

## Overview

- In 2012, San Francisco Unified School District published a working draft of their Family Engagement and Partnership Plan that was developed with input from parents and community members. The plan includes many strategies to increase parent engagement and collaboration between families and schools.

## Importance

- The Draft Family Engagement Plan affirms the importance of school–family partnership and is a major step in ensuring that family engagement becomes a central priority at the school and district levels.

## Steps to Take

- Read the Draft Family Engagement Plan
- Check with your school site to see how parent engagement is occurring at your site
- Figure out how you would like to participate, whether at home, at the school, or at the district or community level.
- Talk to your teacher, principal, or parent engagement representatives (SSC, ELAC or PTA members) about how you can participate.
