

A – G Requirements

Overview

- A–G Requirements are a new set of courses that SFUSD is requiring for students to graduate. The purpose of these requirements is to ensure that students have taken the coursework necessary to be eligible to apply for acceptance to the University of CA system. The standards also ensure that all students in California receive a high quality, rigorous education.

Importance

- Starting in 2014, students must take the A–G courses in order to meet graduation requirements. The most common classes students need to add are two years of a foreign language, a third year of college preparatory math, and lab science.

Steps to Take

- Review the required courses and make sure your child is enrolling in them
- Check with your school counselor to see if your child is on track with these requirements
